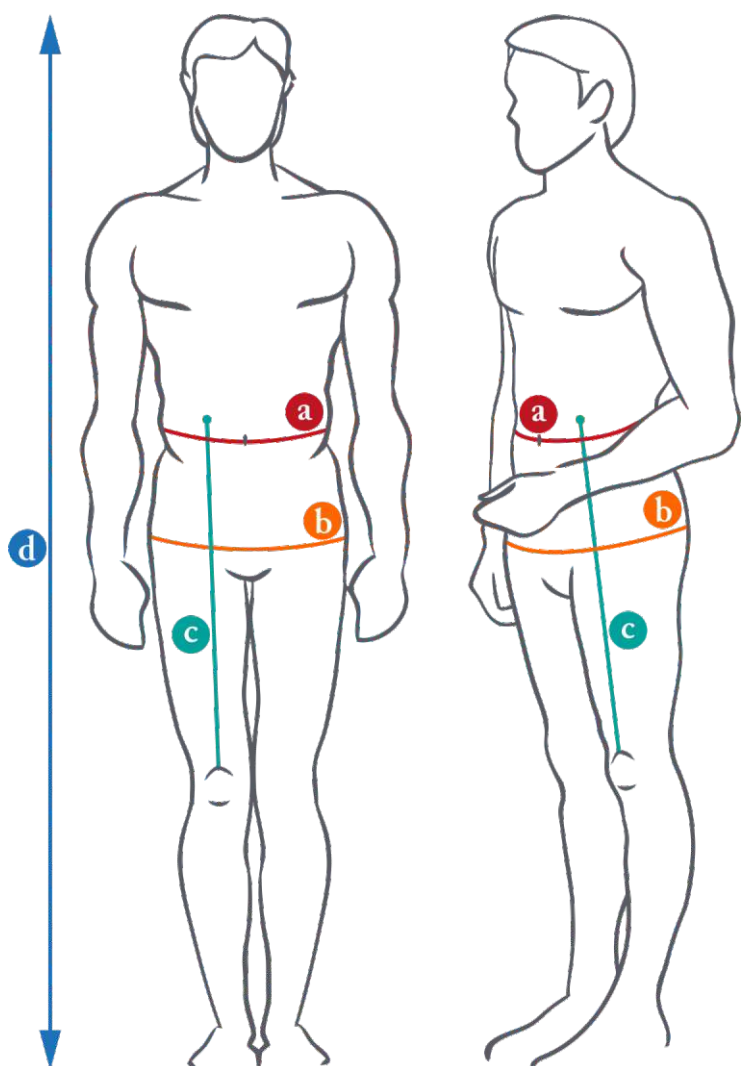




## KILT MEASURING GUIDE

When measuring, please stand straight with your feet together. Remove any bulky clothing and items from your pockets, stand up straight and relax. It's best to have someone else take these measurements for you while you look straight ahead.

- a** **Waist:** Take this firmly, around the natural waist (belly button height). This should be quite a tight measurement - do not be tempted to hold your tummy in while measuring.
- b** **Seat:** Take this measurement loosely, around the fullest/widest part of you hips (bum).
- c** **Drop/Length:** From 2" (5cm) above the natural waist (just below the rib cage) to the top of the knee cap. If you prefer to wear the kilt longer or shorter, please advise this when ordering.
- d** **Height:** Your overall height. (Very important!)
