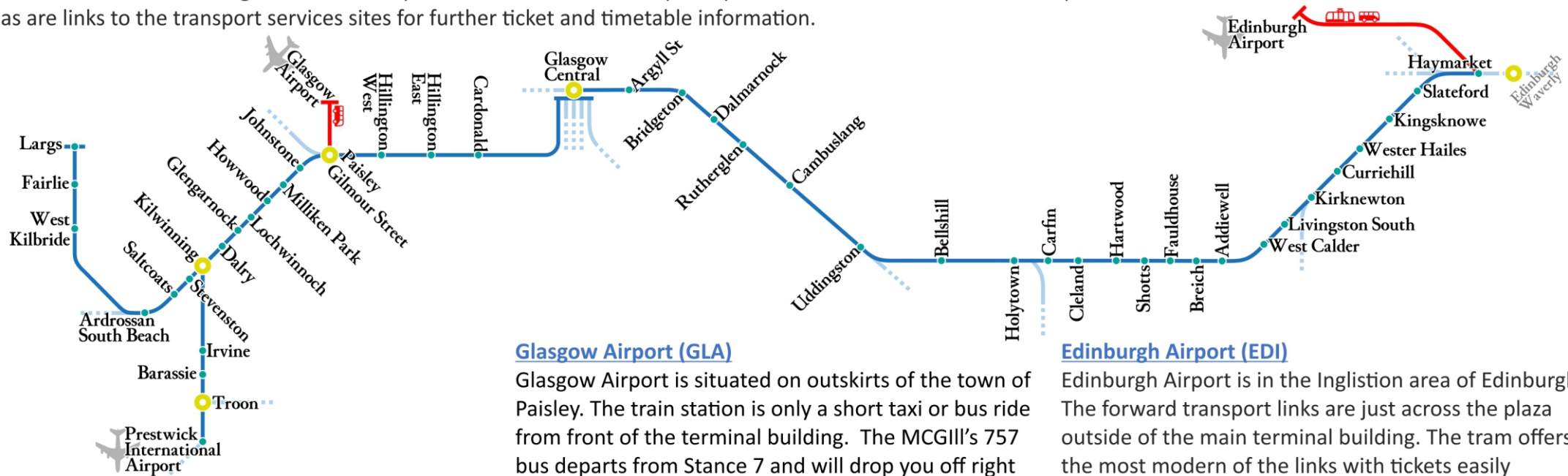


Clan Hunter International Gathering 2021 - Airport transfer information

There are various options for transferring from the airport to your accommodation near Hunterston. Public transport is a popular option and we have great transport links from all our major airports. Assuming you will want to take the least hassle option after your flight we have put together the public transport routes with the least number of changes from each airport. Advice on other transport options is available on each of the airports websites as are links to the transport services sites for further ticket and timetable information.



Glasgow Prestwick Airport (PIK)

Glasgow Prestwick is served by its own railway station which is accessible via a covered walkway from the airport. Tickets are available on the train and qualify for a 50% discount on the standard fare for air passengers (flight confirmation required). You will need to change trains at Kilwinning but should not need to change platform as trains to West Kilbride and Largs usually depart from the same platform (platform 2). Journey time, including waiting time at change, is approx 50 minutes.

Route:

Prestwick Int'l Airport – Kilwinning (Train)

Kilwinning – Largs (Train)

Glasgow Airport (GLA)

Glasgow Airport is situated on outskirts of the town of Paisley. The train station is only a short taxi or bus ride from front of the terminal building. The MCGill's 757 bus departs from Stance 7 and will drop you off right outside Paisley Gilmour Street Station.

The bus to the station usually takes about 15 mins. The trains are regular and tickets can be purchased at the station. The train journey to West Kilbride or Largs will pass through the stations on the above map but may not stop at all of them. This final leg of your journey will take approx 45 mins to 1hr.

Route:

Glasgow Airport – Paisley Gilmour Street

(McGill's 757 bus or Taxi)

Paisley Gilmour Street - Largs (Train)

Edinburgh Airport (EDI)

Edinburgh Airport is in the Ingliston area of Edinburgh. The forward transport links are just across the plaza outside of the main terminal building. The tram offers the most modern of the links with tickets easily available at vending machines at the airport.

Train tickets and departure details are available at the station. As with the other routes the train may not stop at all stations above. The train arrives at Glasgow Central (usually platform 4) and the train to Largs usually departs from platforms 11-14 but departure details are available on the station departure board. Journey time from Edinburgh is upwards of 3 hours.

Route:

Edinburgh Airport – Haymarket

(Tram, Airlink 100 bus or Taxi)

Haymarket - Glasgow Central (Train)

Glasgow Central - Largs (Train)
